STADIUM RULES

1. **ACCESS** – is limited to Match Officials, Team Officials, Players and Emergency Services.
2. **ALCOHOL** – No alcohol is to be consumed by Team Officials, Players during duration of the match.
3. **DRINKS** – NO metal cans, open-top drinks or alcohol is permitted in dug-outs and pitch areas.
4. **FOODS** – No food is to be consumed in the dugout areas or on pitch. *Includes Chewing Gum. Thankyou.*
5. **FOOTWEAR** – Correct footwear is to be worn by Match Officials, Team Staff and Players; inside the dug-outs and pitch areas.
i.e. **NO** 'Thongs, Sandals/Jandals, High-heel Shoes, Steel-cap Boots.
For your safety – enclosed shoes/joggers only please.
6. **TEAM COACHES & OFFICIALS** – to remain 'inside' the dug-out areas; at all times.
Note - Only allowance will be in the Junior J3-8's per Junior Rules of - one roaming coach.
7. **PLAYERS, COACHES OR SPECTATORS** – Are not to sit on the stadium dug-out walls.
8. **JUNIORS SIDELINE (Roaming) COACHES** – as per Rules of Junior Hockey (15.0) MUST wear a Hi-Vis Vest.
This is to be of different colour to Umpires and Teams playing.
9. **UMPIRE MENTORS** – please use the provided 'Pink' Bibs and not wear same shirts as the Umpires to avoid confusion with players & coaches.
10. **UMPIRES** – to ensure you are wearing correct uniform (Just Hockey Shirts or for junior umpires the 'Green Development Umpire Shirts') and that are in presentable fashion to achieving the job. YOUR presentation and that of the players is a 'first seen impression'. *Shirts tucked in.*
11. **TECH BENCH OFFICIALS** - where in place to assist the Umpires in management of Stadium Rules and Match, as per TBO Guidelines.
12. **PHOTOGRAPHERS** – only authorised persons to enter the 'Dug-out & Pitch Area'. Those entering the pitch area are requested to wear a HIGH VIS vests.
13. **NO HIT-UPS** - against the Stadium Dug-out Walls
14. **MATCH BALL** – both teams to have available 'White' hockey ball for matches.
In absence of Association provided ball, the "Game Ball" to be provided by Home Team with other ball held in reserve.
If Tech Bench Officers available, ball should be left with the Tech Bench.
